

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**      No.U9 of 2012

### **BARN ELMS REACH**

### **QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE MOORINGS**

This notice should be read in addition to U4 of 2012.

Mariners are reminded that approximately 200 vessels will be taking up temporary Queen's Diamond Jubilee Pageant Moorings in Barn Elms Reach on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June. It is expected that the first vessel will arrive in Barn Elms Reach at approximate 10:00 with the remaining vessels taking up their moorings by 13:30.

These vessels will moor, rafted up two abreast until the start of the Pageant and will have fendering in place, however there remains a risk for potential damage. Therefore we request that vessel movements in this section of the river are kept to an absolute minimum and if you have to navigate through these moorings, then caution should be exercised, keeping wash to an absolute minimum.

Please remember that a River Closure will come into force at 06:00 from Kew Bridge to Grosvenor Railway Bridge as per NTM 20 of 2012.
